Writing

We are working on Narratives and looking at what is in them. We will brainstorm and fill out a planning sheet based on a narrative already written. Then they will begin planning their own narrative.

Health

We will look at specific foods in the meat/alternatives, and dairy products. We will also look at the importance of daily physical activities and what they do to keep their bodies clean.

ENGLISH

We are looking at narratives and looking and it's structure in English as well. We will look at different popular fairytales that have been changed (Fractured Fairytales). They will begin thinking of creating their own.

Math

We will be learning numbers up to 1000 in French.

We will continue to look at representing numbers up to 900, using manipulatives, numbers and pictures.

Facts to 18 (Being able to add 2 numbers up to 9+9 and find the answer (sum) with automaticity.

Doubles with 2 digits without regrouping

Skip counting by 1, 2, 5, 10, 25, and 100.

2 digit addition without regrouping.
