MATH

Oral Communication

For the rest of the year, there won't be specific sentence structures learned. Our Literacy program will be intergrated with our Health, Social Studies, and Science units.

Reading

We have completed our sounds. I am now testing students in reading. Books should be going home. They can read the same book for a few days to develop fluency.

2 digit addition with and without regrouping.

Subtraction using mental math and using a number line.
