LITERACY

SOCIAL STUDIES, SCIENCE AND HEALTH

MATH

Oral Communication

For the rest of the year, there won't be specific sentence structures learned. Our Literacy program will be intergrated with our Health, Social Studies, and Science units.

Reading

Students are bringing books home at their level. We are reading every day during our intergrated units, French, and Daily 5 (Reading to self, Reading to another, Guided Reading with teacher, Listening to Reading, and Reading in Groups)

After reading stories or texts, we retell them, using the Shape-Go-Map (beginning, middle, and end)

Writing

We are doing a description of a person or an animal of our choice.

Science

In our Structures unit, we are going to look at things used to combine materials together, parts of a building and what makes them solid, the structure of a building, and arches and triangles in a structure.

ENGLISH

Reading

We are going to focus on reading. We're going to read a book and participate in conversations about the book, recognize the elements of a story, and be able to express and explain opinions about the text demonstrating an increasing awareness for the reasons for their opinions

Math

We will be learning numbers up to 1000 in French.

We will continue to look at representing numbers up to 1000, using manipulatives, numbers and pictures.

Finding partners to 10, 20, and 100, Facts to 18. Doubles

Skip counting by 1, 2, 5, 10, 25, and 100.

3 digit addition with and without regrouping.

Subtraction using mental math and 2x2 and 3x3 subtraction, using a strategy of their choice.

Fractions of a whole (identifying fraction, drawing a fraction, and comparing fractions with a same denominator.
