## MATH

### Oral Communication

We are learning about our community and learning vocabulary and sentences to describe our neighbourhood. (See Writing)

### Reading

We will be learning about the following sounds:

### Writing

We will continue to look at representing numbers up to 500, using manipulatives, numbers and pictures. Representing:

Facts to 18 (Being able to add 2 numbers up to 9+9 and find the answer (sum) with automaticity)

Skip counting by 1, 2, 5, 10, 25, and 100.
