Facts to 18 (Being able to add 2 numbers up to $9+9$ and find the answer (sum) with automaticity.

Skip counting by 1, 2, 5, 10, 25, and 100.

Equality number sentences:

$$6 + 8 = 4 + \underline{\quad}$$
